Categorizing Christians: Writers Coming to Terms with the Crowd at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, c. 1400-1600

For nearly two millennia, pilgrims from all over the Christian world have flocked to Jerusalem and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre (CHS). The CHS does not belong to a single Christian denomination—in fact, two Muslim families are in charge of the key. Still today, Christians from different churches and different continents (Africa, Asia, Europe) worship each according to their specific rite, side by side with other Christians. In my presentation I will highlight how pilgrims and travellers around 1500 would make sense of the bewildering ethno-religious variety they encountered at the CHS.
